SECRETARY'S REPORT

B. Brown presented the schedule for building delivery for Walton Crossing 1 and 2. Crossing 1 is 49 days behind schedule with the first building expected September 14, 2025, and the final building on October 5, 2025. Crossing 2 is on schedule with the first apartment to be turned over February 15, 2026, and final apartments March 15, 2026. Board requested we post when applications will be accepted.

Discussion of next steps with Hunter Street to approach the city council as project will clean up blight and create workforce housing. Future goals were also discussed to redevelop Hunter Street.
